	Certain language changes were		
	proposed, for example: telehealth vs		
	telemedicine. There's focus on		
	different models of telehealth. New		
	practice models, sites, and faculty is		
	expected to expand partnerships in		
	JAX and ORL. It was decided that		
	creating a listerv for faculty across		
	college for sending out invitations		
	would be beneficial. Expanding		
	students' knowledge of ability to		
	pivot in their career was		
	emphasized. Need to get the		
	message out to students that		
	electives grades won't impact their		
	GPA in terms of honors or probation.		
	Motivate them to select electives		
	they're interested in, not whichever		
	is an easy A. It was pointed out that		
	there used to be only 4 goals, now		
	there's 5. 4&5 were once combined.		
	There's now more emphasis on D&I		
	and we're purposely seek out		
	underrepresented minorities as		
	students. The 5 <sup>th</sup> goal is a hybrid		
	effort b/w Faculty Dev (Segal) and		
	Dr. Tebbett's work.

	that students were testing notably		
	better on their iRATS remotely vs in		
	class. However, this has not been the		
	case for exams. Need to determine		
	what makes the difference and		
	possibly have students show a video		

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	of their surroundings prior to taking	
	any kind of test/quiz to avoid the	
	potential for cheating. Another	
	theory was offered that perhaps the	
	reason students are doing better	
	remotely is because they're test	
	taking in a space where they would	
	normally study. They may be in a	
	better state of mind feeling more	
	comfortable and focused.	
	Action items: Develop methods to	
	reduce the possibility of cheating	
	and consider factors that may	
	contribute to higher scores on iRATS	
	when testing remotely vs in class.
