Discussion: T&P	Action Items:	Mobley/Frye	
Guideline Revision	-Non-tenure track is ambiguous and		
	needs the most work. The document that		
	we have now for non-tenure track faculty		
	needs to cover promotion transition		
	process more clearly.		
	-Clinical track vs research vs lecture track		
	needs to be clearly defined and		
	separated.		
	- Consider adopting the single-mission,		
	multi-mission non-tenure track faculty		
	system utilized by other UF health		
	professions colleges.		

	- Consider requiring education portfolios		
	for faculty who have significant teaching		
	responsibilities and clinical portfolios for		
	faculty who have significant clinical		
	responsibilities. This would be consistent		
	with other UF health professions colleges.		
	- Admin service distinction needs work.		
	- Achievement of national reputation is		
	NOT required for faculty in single mission		
	and multi-mission for other colleges,		
	which deviates from COP. Need to look		
	into this.		
	Committee Decision:	1	
	- Adopt the single-mission, multi-mission		
	faculty track system for non-tenure track		
	faculty. Outline assignment percentages		
	in single and multi-mission category, start		
	with clinical vs research then branch out		
	into single and multiple missions. Look at		
	other guidelines to see how they're		
	,		
	organized. Keep as one document		
	containing both tenure and non-tenure		
	track. – Frye, Frazier, and Mobley will		
	create an outline delineating the different		
	tracks with a goal of improving current		
	guidelines so that it provides clear		
	guidance to all stakeholders		
	- Require an educational portfolio for		
	faculty with significant teaching		
	responsibility. The portfolio should be		
	consistent with the Teacher of the Year		
	portfolio, but will likely be briefer – Frye		
	and Mobley will work on this		
	- Decision not made regarding the		
	requirement for a clinical portfolio for		
	faculty who have a significant clinical		
	responsibility. This will be revisited.		
	- T&P revision subgroups will send		
	reports of their work to Mobley
